Hours of Work

Currently sessions 2.5 hours (5.45-8.15) Tuesday and Thursday evenings – term time only.

There is the potential to increase this to more sessions during term time and school holiday activities depending on funding and the development of a strategic plan for Youth Work activities within Southam.

Role

Key tasks:

- To help develop and deliver youth work programmes in collaboration with other staff.
- To organise and deliver crafts / sports and / or theme based activities.
- Establishing relationships and a style of working that will enable young people to safely learn and develop, in accordance with the principles and values of youth work.
- Promoting the participation of young people in the activities of Southam Youth Club.
- Supporting the monitoring and evaluating of sessional work including providing input into sessional reports.
- To familiarise yourself within the local community amenities and providers of services for young people.
- To work within the Southam Church and Community Project's policies and procedures, knowledge of safeguarding children and young people.

- To carry out other duties as may be deemed necessary by the Committee or Board in line with the aims of the service.

- be trustworthy and reliable
