Exam 1 (33.3% of overall grade):

Philosophy of Religion (A Level Tuesday 2nd June)

Exam 2 (33.3% of overall grade):

Religion and Ethics (A Level Tuesday 9th June)

Exam 3 (33.3% of overall grade):

Developments in Christian Thought (A Level Monday 15th June)

As A Level, students have to answer three questions (from a choice of four) on each paper. The questions are marked out of 40 and assess the pupils on the following skills:

A01 = Knowledge and Understanding (40%)

A02 = Analysis and Evaluation (60%)

Students must demonstrate both skills in their written work. They must prepare to answer questions in the following areas:
